The Dominican Republic was discovered in 1492 by Columbus and since then the island has seen both abundance and abyss. Through generations of civil wars, dictatorships, corruption, steep inflation and the widespread deterioration of public services, Dominicans live with little hope of receiving modern medical care.



While the Dominican Republic is not as poor as other countries due to a healthy tourism industry, it has an underdeveloped medical society. Government hospitals are visibly run-down and filled with obsolete equipment. The children's wards are incredibly disturbing. At one facility, the children were located in the basement with two or three to a bed with little or no lighting and no real place to receive rehabilitative exercise.

Blessed by the assistance of a CURE board member for the construction of a hospital, CURE is now meeting children's needs in the Dominican Republic with compassionate care. This hospital is our first venture in Latin America and will serve as our regional headquarters supporting future hospitals in Honduras, and Central and South America.

CURE provides children the opportunity to experience real paradise by walking, running or even smiling for the first time in their lives.
